Active Shooter – Quick Clear Response

March 26

Rapid intervention and domination of the effected structure is the hallmark of a good active shooter response plan. Quick Clear Response provides the needed training and expertise to offer officers a viable, quick to learn, easy to remember and execute system for bringing a critical incident to a close. Based on basic building search and contact cover techniques, QCR can be started with as few officers as are immediately available and can be built upon at any point.

Participant Requirement: Gun belt, red/blue gun or duty weapon with ammo safe

Officer Down Rescue March 27

Rescuing a downed officer who is still in the line of fire is a skill that is not often taught to patrol officers or detectives, but can be invaluable when the chips are down. This hands-on course will cover a wide range of scenarios and will demonstrate an even wider range of options. Participants will learn tactics for rescuing a downed officer or civilian in a building, open area or a vehicle. It will also show several field expedient modes of extracting downed individuals by use of patrol cars and other vehicles or tools that are commonly available to patrol officers and detectives during their tour of duty.

Participant Requirement: Gun belt, red/blue gun or duty weapon with ammo safe



Field Trauma Care for Police Officers * Includes Trauma Pak

March 28

This training explores the survivability rate of traumatic injuries when immediate care is applied in the field prior to EMS intervention. Officers will leave this hands-on course knowing how to address a life threatening injury to themselves or another officer and the proper application of necessary medical equipment.

Officers will understand why it is imperative to have crucial supplies within reach at all times.
